ROAD TO REMEMBRANCE

For every £15 we receive, £5 goes directly to charity with the additional £10 being used to purchase, convert and compete a car in the 12 hour Race of Remembrance, in November 2021. At the end of the project the car will be auctioned to the highest bidder or continued to race for Mission Motorsport and all proceeds and left over funds will also be donated.

The 'Road to Remembrance' project will kick off with the purchase of an every day road vehicle, which will be expertly converted, over the course of 9 months, to eventually take part in the Race of Remembrance in November 2021.

The entire journey will be documented by our film crew, in a Top Gear style series, and posted to our Youtube Channel, Social Media Accounts and Website.

Hosted by Pole Position Prize's Ian Waterhouse and Sponsored Driver Bradley Gravett, this one off story will not only cover a professional car build, but also guest interviews, behind the scenes sneak-peeks, guides on going racing and on track action.

The 'Road to Remembrance' project will culminate in LIVE coverage of the 12 hour endurance race and a special feature episode of the event unfolding.

This is a journey not to be missed.

THE ROAD MAP



A unique car for a unique event

The vehicle selected for the 'Road to Remembrance' is the BMW E90. While the petrol variant is a common enough sight in UK paddocks, we have opted for the diesel version. Why? We hear you ask. The answer? POWER.

Offering flexible tuning capabilities, ample amounts of torque and boasting a fuel advantage over it's rivals, when we're finished this Monster of Motorsport will produce more torque than a Ferrari. If that doesn't turn heads, we don't know what will.

The car will be saved from a mundane life as a road vehicle and transformed into a Monster of Motorsport, over the course of the project. As donations are received our expert team of engineers will be carrying out each stage of the build, which will be documented by our filming team.

An Iconic endurance event for a good cause

Run annually by Mission Motorsport, the Race of Remembrance is a 12 hour endurance event held at the historic Trac Mon Circuit, in Anglesey. A weekend of racing with a unique twist, the event stops midway through for a service in honour of our veterans. Streamed LIVE for the full 12 hours, the race attracts some of the biggest names in Motorsport.

The Pole Position Prizes car will be no different - piloted by non-other than British Touring Car Champion Robb Gravett and his son Bradley Gravett, with a beneficiary from Mission Motorsport and a mystery guest driver, to complete the 4 man team.





Although the focus and ultimate goal of the project is to raise a minimum of £10,000 for Mission Motorsport, we also want to ensure that all the businesses that make this project possible are recognised.

When a new company joins the project, by donating their £15, we will add a 5cm x 5cm sticker to the livery of the race car, featuring the company branding (or an image of their choosing). All businesses will be included on our dedicated Web Page, used to track the progress of the project from start to finish and shared across our social media pages.

We will provide full access to our activities, including the use of pictures that can be used to engage your customers and followers.

The 'Race to Remembrance' Project provides the opportunity to be involved in a record breaking journey and support our veterans and armed service soldiers in getting the rehabilitation and helping hand they need to start a new career after the military.
